
Daily Uniform

- Emerald green school sweatshirts and cardigans (available to order from the school website/office).
- White polo-shirt or shirt, and grey or black trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafore dresses. Alternatively, green and white striped/checked dresses may be worn.
- Socks/tights should preferably be dark in colour or white.
- Shoes should be plain black (with closed-toed sandals also permitted).

P.E.

- Yellow t-shirt, green shorts and trainers/plimsolls.
- In colder weather, a school jumper and plain/dark tracksuit bottoms may also be worn.


