

Daily tasks- reading, CLIC and phonics.

Reading practise:

- Read for 15 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Talk about what has been read.

CLIC:

- Count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's backwards and forwards from any given number.
- Practise recalling the following learn its taught in Year 1. ($4+2=6$, $5+2=7$, $6+2=8$, $7+2=9$, $8+2=10$, $9+2=11$, $4+3=7$, $5+3=8$, $6+3=9$, $7+3=10$, $8+3=11$, $9+3=12$)
Challenge: what would $14+2$ be? How about $15+3$? What happens if you turn one of the numbers into a teen number?
- Solve addition and subtraction within 30 using a number line or counting objects.

Phonics:

Practise spelling the following high frequency words correctly: **what**, **was**, **were**, **where**, **here**

- Day 1: complete the work sheet finding **au** graphemes in the text and answer the questions.
- Day 2: complete the work sheet finding **ew** graphemes in the text and answer the questions.
- Day 3: complete the work sheet finding **split digraphs** in the text and answer the questions.
- Day 4: complete the work sheet finding **ir** graphemes in the text and answer the questions.
- Day 5: complete the work sheet finding **ay** in the text and answer the questions.
