
Phoneme Frames


We use phoneme frames to help us segment the different sounds in words. We put one sound into each box. We need to remember that a sound may have more than one letter in (like the digraphs and trigraphs that we learn).





This week, in school, we will be using phoneme frames along with magnetic letters, letters on stones, etc.
