My notes for the newsletter today have been inspired by some of the creative, imaginative and engaging ways in which I have seen children here at school taking part in different reading activities this week. I had the pleasure of leading a tour around the school with a prospective parent who commented to me just how much of a positive feel around reading there was in all of the classrooms we visited. Whilst it was lovely to get that feedback, I am very aware that the importance of reading both at school and at home cannot be overemphasised and it remains perhaps the most fundamental key to unlocking so much of the world of learning for our children.

In terms of support from home, regular reading is essential to support development here in school - we would recommend five times weekly in most cases. Supporting your child with reading can take many forms, not just listening to them read. For all children, as well as regular reading we would encourage lots of talk around the books they are reading - what are you enjoying about the book, what do you think might happen next, which character would you most like to meet? 'Book Talk' can of course happen any where, any time - even in the car on the way to the shops or on the walk to/from school! If you would like any ideas for book choices for your child or for any other support, please do get in touch with your child's class teacher.



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
