Non-fiction books are information books. They are about real things and they contain facts. This is different to fiction books that are created from someone's imagination. This week we are going to help the Non-fiction Ninjas to find out more about non-fiction texts and then write our own.

Task 1:

Find out about the features of a non-fiction book.

Look at some non-fiction books with an adult. You might have some on your bookshelf or you can visit Oxford Owl and look at some non-fiction e-books. There are login details and suggested book titles below. On the school website there is a document called 'Non-Fiction Ninjas Features of a Text'. Have a look at this document and see how many of the different features you can find in your book.

Extra challenge: Use post-it notes or paper strips to label the features that you find and then tell an adult about why each feature is important, e.g. the index tells us the meaning of important topic words.
