| Monday | Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter <br> and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs <br> sheet. <br> Find the sound 'th' on your sheet. Write it in your book. Ask a <br> grown-up or older sibling to read the following words: thin, that, <br> this, thanks, with. Segment the words and write them in your book. <br> Choose one of the words and think of a sentence with that word in. |
| Tuesday | Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter <br> and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs <br> sheet. <br> Write the 'ng' digraph in your book. Look at the pictures below and <br> write down a word to match each picture. Choose one of the words <br> and write a sentence with that word in. |
| Wednesday | Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter <br> and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs <br> sheet. <br> Find the sound 'oo' on your sheet. The 'oo' digraph makes two <br> sounds - a long sound like in the word 'food' and a short sound like <br> in the word 'book'. Make a table to write some words with the <br> different 'oo' sounds in (please see example below). |
| Thursday | Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter <br> and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs <br> sheet. <br> Look at the 'oo' words that you read and wrote yesterday. Choose <br> two words, think and write a sentence with those words in e.g. I <br> have a cook book. or The food looks good. |
| Friday | Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter <br> and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs <br> sheet. <br> Read all of your orange tricky words again. Spell them out loud <br> using the letter names. Ask an adult or older sibling to read 4 of the <br> tricky words and try to write them down without looking at the <br> card. |
