Day	Activity
Monday	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Find the sound 'th' on your sheet. Write it in your book. Ask a grown-up or older sibling to read the following words: <i>thin, that, this, thanks, with</i>. Segment the words and write them in your book. Choose one of the words and think of a sentence with that word in.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Write the 'ng' digraph in your book. Look at the pictures below and write down a word to match each picture. Choose one of the words and write a sentence with that word in.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Find the sound 'oo' on your sheet. The 'oo' digraph makes two sounds – a long sound like in the word 'food' and a short sound like in the word 'book'. Make a table to write some words with the different 'oo' sounds in (please see example below).</p>
Thursday	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Look at the 'oo' words that you read and wrote yesterday. Choose two words, think and write a sentence with those words in e.g. <i>I have a cook book.</i> or <i>The food looks good.</i></p>
Friday	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Read all of your orange tricky words again. Spell them out loud using the letter names. Ask an adult or older sibling to read 4 of the tricky words and try to write them down without looking at the card.</p>

Remember: When writing a sentence, have you got your capital letter, finger spaces and full stop?
