















Pop Art: Self-portrait

You will need the following:

- A black felt-tip pen (or any other black pen)
- Coloured felt-tip pens these will stand out really well. If you have coloured pencils, you may need to apply pressure when trying to make the colour striking and bold.
- Paper
- Ruler (optional some people have used them to help when doing Ben Day Dots)

Task: Draw a self-portrait (a drawing of yourself) using Ben Day Dots to add colour.

- 1. It is always useful to see your face, so try taking a photo and use that to draw your face shape, hairline and facial features.
- 2. Draw your face in pencil. When you're happy with it, go over it in black felt-tip pen. Some parts (e.g. strands of hair, nostrils) may need thicker lines than others.
- 3. Draw an exploding word in the background of your piece. It could have your name inside of it or any that you feel complement your piece.
- 4. Colour your piece. Which parts will you use Ben Day Dots for? Which will be bold colour? Plan your colour choices carefully as Pop Art is fun and bold!
