Make up a story about a child travelling back in time to the Egyptian Age. Make sure your story has got an introduction, build up, problem, resolution and ending. Add as much historical detail as possible to make your time travel convincing. Does your character end up living in a royal palace? Or in the desert? What does he/she get up to in Egyptian times, and do they manage to get back to 2020?

The adage 'you can't take it with you' would have horrified wealthy Egyptians, who packed their tombs with their favourite jewellery. Create a piece of jewellery. You coud use pasta, clay, plasticine, junk modelling.

Challenge: make your jewellery as colouurful as possible using authentic Egyptian colours (gold, red, green, blue)
