


Week 7

Day	Activity
Monday	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Look at the pictures below that all include the adjacent consonants 'fl'. Write a word to match each picture. Can you think of any more words that have 'fl' in? If you can, write them down and draw a picture to match.
Tuesday	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Write the adjacent consonants 'br' and 'cr' at the top of your page in your book. Ask a grown-up or older sibling to read the following words: <i>brush, crush, bring, cling</i> . Segment the words and write them under the correct adjacent consonant in your book. Choose one of the words and write a sentence with that word in.
Wednesday	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Ask a grown up to read the postcard below. Every time you hear the 'lk' or 'lp' adjacent consonants, clap! How many did you hear? Have a go reading it by yourself afterwards.
Thursday	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Read the questions below and answer them – yes or no.
Friday	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Read all of your purple tricky words. Spell them out loud using the letter names. In your book, try and write them down without looking at them.

I am on a trip to a farm. We get to be the farm helpers all week. It is so much fun!


My sister got to milk a cow but the cow stood on her foot. She did a yelp and went off in a sulk so I had to help.
