This Week

This week we have continued our explorations of The Magic Porridge Pot. The highlight was making and eating our own porridge! The children have created some super shopping lists and picture recipes to share the process. Take a look at the Foundation blog for some photos. We have also looked at the story of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, noticing similarities and differences between the two traditional tales.

In phonics this week, we have introduced:

ck as in duck e as in egg u as in umbrella r as in robot

The children have been using letter resources to record CVC words, applying all of their new phonics knowledge.

In maths we have been exploring the number 3, finding different ways of making and representing this amount. We have also been using 'more' and 'less' to compare amounts and sorted items by size, using mathematical vocabulary to talk about our work.
