

# Daily Handwriting Practice

This week our handwriting is the da join.

It is tricky to show you the correct join on the computer. Before you start, have a look in the 'Handwriting book' and find our join. Look at where it sits on the line, what size the letters are and how they are joined together.

## Monday

Write out two lines of the join. Remember to leave a finger space in between each join.

For example: da da da da da da da da da da da

## Tuesday

Write out the join 5 times and make a list of 10 words with the join in them.

For example: da da da da da

danger, dancing, dalmatian, dairy, diary

## Wednesday

Choose three of your words from yesterday. Write three sentences that include each of your words in them (one sentence for each word).

For example: A dalmatian is a breed of dog, usually they have white fur with black spots.

## Thursday

Invent 5 new words, these words must all have our handwriting join in them.

For example: daffur, endap, fruadat, yadabe, dax

## Friday

Write a definition for each of your made up words.

For example: Dax - a tiny, friendly elephant.
