Daily tasks- reading, phonics and Clic

Reading practise:

- Read for 10 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Can your child identify the adjectives (words describing a person, place or thing) in the text?

Clic:

- Each day practise counting in twos to 20 and back again.

 Challenge Can you count beyond 20 in twos? Can you spot a pattern with the multiples of 2? (End in 0, 2,4,6,8 = even numbers)
- Learn off by heart 0+10=10, 1+9=10, 2+8=10, 3+7=10, 4+6=10, 5+5=10
- Write out the fact families for your Learn its.

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e.g. 4+6=10
6+4=10
10-6=4
10-4=6
10=4+6
10=6+4
6=10-4
4=10-6
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Phonics:

Each day write the following words onto small cards. Introduce the sound and words to your child. Place them in a pot or hoop at one end of your garden or hallway. Your child can race to collect a word and bring it back to you. Your child can keep the card if he/she can sound out and blend the word. How many can she/he collect in 2 minutes? Try again to beat the score or bring the time down to give more challenge.

- Day 2 soft c cell ice icy rice spice face space place December central centre certain except cancel
- Day 3 hard g goat goal game gate finger hungry good goose gold gift dragon gloomy
- Day 4 soft g gem age page stage huge magic danger gentle orange
