

## Week Beginning 18 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ January 2021

| Day | Activity |
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| Monday | Watch the video: https://youtu.be/UqNZ2isUZZY <br> Today we will be exploring the numbers to 20. You will need your number cards <br> Extra challenge: Use Lego or bricks to build towers of 11 to 15, then put them in order <br> from smallest to largest amount. It is a bit like building your own Numberblocks! You <br> could match the towers to your number cards. |
| Tuesday | Watch the video: https://youtu.be/SSbD5qcLzDO <br> Today we are using 'part, part, whole' models to add 10s and 1s to find a whole. You <br> will need your number cards and there are printable Numicon pieces on the school <br> website which might be useful but are not necessary to take part in the session. <br> Extra challenge: Look at the 'part, part, whole' models on the school website. Can you <br> use dots to show the 10s and 1s for the whole amount? You can print the sheet or ask <br> an adult to help you copy it onto paper. |
| Wednesday | Practise counting from 0 to 20. You could join in with one of the action videos below. <br> Then spread your number cards out on the floor or table, ask an adult to say a number <br> name and see how quickly you can find and 'splat' it (put your hand on it). You could <br> play with someone else and see who spots the correct number card first. Keep the cards <br> you 'splat' and then order them from lowest to highest number. <br> Extra challenge: Look for numbers around the house or when you go for a walk. Can <br> you spot any teens numbers? You might see them on doors or car number plates. |
| Thursday | Watch the video: https://youtu.be/5QKoOrRZIUg <br> Today we are going shopping! You will need a 1Op coin and ten 1p coins. <br> Extra challenge: Do some coin rubbings to show the different amounts you made when <br> problem solving. |
| Friday | In school, your friends will be looking at any numbers that they have found especially <br> tricky this week and we would like you to do the same. Is there a number that was <br> tricky to remember the name off or to say in the right place when counting? If there is, <br> watch the Numberblocks episode for that number (links below). You might like to watch <br> more than one. Spot which Numberblock characters are making up the teen number. <br> Extra challenge: Play a board game with a numbered board such as the snakes and <br> ladders game from last week. |
