List them in your homework book.</p> <p>Pronoun, noun, verb, adjective, adverb, preposition, conjunction, connective.</p> <p>Challenge: Write a paragraph that includes every word type. Can you colour code them?</p>	<p>What did the Romans do for us?</p> <p>The Romans were skilled engineers and architects. Create a poster to showcase their many inventions.</p> <p>You might want to research:</p> <p>Aqueducts, underfloor heating, straight roads, the Julian calendar.</p>
<p>Join a family member in measuring out a recipe. Read the scales to make sure you use the correct amount of each ingredient.</p> <p>Write the ingredient list in your book.</p> <p>Challenge: What if you cooked the recipe for the whole class? Can you calculate how much of each ingredient you would need?</p>	<p>Write a weather forecast in French.</p> <p>Try drawing a map of your local area, or the UK. Draw weather symbols and label them in French.</p> 
<p>Create an autumn mosaic. How you create your mosaic and what you use is up to you!</p>	<p>Design a musical instrument from recycled materials. Draw a labelled diagram and list the materials you would need to collect to make it.</p>
