


Marvellous Maths



Week Beginning 13th July 2020

Everyday warm-up: Count up to 20 in funny voices. Make sure you say the 'teen' ending clearly.

Day	Activity
Monday	Look at the ice cream menu on the school website and work out how much the adults in school had to pay for their ice creams! Remember to use a number line or counting toys to help you with your problem solving. Extra challenge: Find the cost of the ice cream – worksheet on website.
Tuesday	Look at the ice cream menu on the school website and imagine that you are choosing an ice cream. Pick a flavour and a topping. How much will your ice cream cost? Find out by adding the two prices. Remember to use counting toys or a number line to help you. Maybe you could do this when you are having a real ice cream at home and 'pay' for your treat with coins! Extra challenge: Use the recording cards (second page) to colour the ice cream you ordered and record the number sentence.
Wednesday	Practise your addition or subtraction by completing one of the ice cream colour by number pictures on the school website. Remember to use a number line or counting toys to help you with your problem solving. Extra challenge: Choose a second sheet to complete. You might try a different type of calculation or you could challenge yourself with higher numbers.
Thursday	In school we will be taking part in end of term activities on Thursday and Friday. There is information about them on the website, please join in at home. Our maths on these two days will be number formation and/or maths games, such as the ones below:
