This week we have been sharing Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson. The children have used the construction resources, both indoors and out, to build new brooms for the witch. They have also been creating their own magic potions, counting ingredients into a cauldron and recording their recipes.

In maths we have continued to look at tens frames, using counting toys to explore the different ways of making 5 and 6.

In phonics we have learnt the tricky word 'to' and:

as in umbrella r as in red

We have also shared our experiences of Bonfire Night and created some super firework art.
