Daily tasks-reading, CLIC and phonics.

Reading practise:

- Read for 10 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Can you see where the full stops are? Can you see any other punctuation marks such as question marks, exclamation marks or speech marks?

CLIC:

- Count in 2's, 5's, 10's and 1's form any given number backwards and forwards within 100.
- Learn the following calculation facts: half of 18 is 9 because 9+9=18
 half of 16 is 8 because 8+8=16
 half of 14 is 7 because 7+7=14
 half of 12 is 6 because 6+6=12
- What would 90+90 equal? (you could hide the 0 and solve 9+9 then add back the 0 to the answer) How about 80+80, 70+70, 60+60,

Phonics:

Every day practise spelling the following tricky words correctly: where, who, again, laughed, because. Can you get them all right by Friday?

- Day 1 collect words with <u>dge</u> trigraph and have a go at writing them down: hedge, fridge, lodge, smudge, fudge. (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 2 collect words with <u>igh</u> trigraph and have a go at writing them down: night, knight, fright, light, bright (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 3- collect words with <u>air</u> trigraph and have a go at writing them down: fair, hair, repair, stairs, chair (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 4 collect words with <u>ear</u> trigraph and have a go at writing them down: hear, clear, tears, near, fear (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 5 Enjoy playing various phonics games on <u>www.phonicsplay.co.uk</u>
