Enrolments.

- > If you wish to enrol in clubs for the Autumn term, please complete an enrolment form (1 per child) and provide the relevant payments as indicated on the form. Additional forms can be obtained from the school foyer.
- Please write your child's name(s) on the back of any cheques, together with the name of the club which they are attending. Please use one cheque for each club NO CASH If this causes a problem please speak to Julie Symonds to make arrangements.
- Cheques will NOT be banked until the clubs start in September.
- > There is no facility to pay online for clubs which are run by Third Party Providers
- > ONLINE PAYMENTS FOR SCHOOL STAFF LED CLUBS: If you are paying by the online School Gateway system please pay online once your place as been confirmed by Julie Symonds.
- > One free club place is available to all children who have applied for Pupil Premium funding.
- > You will always be told if a club is full and your child does not have a place as soon as your form has been processed. You will not receive details of your chosen club until the end of the first week of term to ensure that there are enough enrolments for that club to run.

<u>CHOIR CLUB-</u> This has moved day due to Mrs Turner's work schedule. Existing Choir Members are given first priority for this club due to the commitment they show during out of school events. Any spare places will be given on a first come first served basis.

<u>HOCKEY CLUB</u> - This club is aimed at just the older children so that they can start with Quickstick hockey and then progress to Junior Hockey using wooden hockey sticks

NATURE GARDEN CLUB - Please note that this club will only run for the first half of term. Children will need old clothes and wellington boots or old sturdy shoes. The children will work in both the nature garden and the allotments and may also take part in some firepit activities, developing bushcraft and whittling skills.

FOOTBALL CLUB - Football Club is for both boys and girls and we now have two separate clubs splitting the age groups up.

<u>TWANGY MATHS</u> - This club will run for the first half term only. Twangy Maths is for mathematicians who like to play around with patterns and ideas and twang a few mathematical concepts around and see how far they stretch. If you like problem solving and wondering about stuff then this might be just up your street.

FRENCH CLUB - If your child is new to French Club then there is an extra charge for the book and CD which needs to be paid direct to Sam Gallop at the beginning of term (£17).

<u>KARATE CLUB</u> - The children will have the opportunity to work through the grades/belts with Nato at a cost of £30 for colour belts and £45 for Brown belts (1 grading per term) but this is entirely optional. Karate suits are not essential. They may also be given the opportunity to join Karate Tournaments outside of school at an extra cost.

<u>BALLET & MODERN DANCE</u> - Please do not fill in an enrolment form for this club, please contact Rose directly. The ballet timetable (which starts on 9th September through to 16th December 2019) is as follows;
