Our discussions around 'pro-social' behaviour, pupil well-being, 'educational and protective' consequences and strategies to further support positive interactions with others, were an inspiring way for us to start the term. As we have always done, through whole school and year group assemblies and teaching opportunities in class, the EJ Way behaviour code is at the heart of everything we do. Please do talk to your children to ask about their understanding of one this week's words from assembly - 'pro-social' and how this applies to all of our time in and out of school. Thank you!

- Behaviour which is positive, helpful, and promotes social acceptance.
- Behaviour characterised by a concern for the rights and feelings of others.
- Behaviour which **benefits other people** or society.
