Personal Topic

This half term in Year 6 we ask you to research a topic of our choice. This year we would like you to find out about someone who inspires you.

This person could be a scientist, a musician, a designer, a mathematician, a sports person, a campaigner or politician, an author, an artist, an engineer, a poet.. or perhaps a very ordinary person who did something really significant and who made a real difference in some way. This person can be alive now or can be drawn from any time in history. This person can be a man or woman, adult or child.

You need to find out about their family background and early life; their influences and things they did before they became significant and you need to be able to explain and justify why you think they are special and inspirational. Make sure you include their achievements and things that make them famous.

You can present your ideas as a poster or leaflet; an ICT presentation or podcast or short film. You can write a booklet or draw a cartoon. You might include photos, pictures, maps, charts, diagrams, interviews and paragraphs of written information. It really is up to you.

You should find your information from a variety of sources and list these at the end. If you use different books, please write down the title and author. Please list the websites you use too. Make sure you use your own words and do not copy and paste information please.

This is a piece of work that will last several weeks, not just this week, so think carefully about choosing someone who is interesting to you and for whom there is plenty of evidence and material to draw upon.
