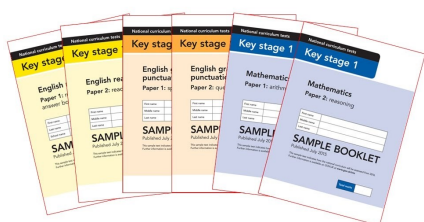

There has been considerable conversation and debate in the media in the last few days about the role of formal testing in primary schools as it has been the national Key Stage 2 (Year 6) test week this week. A week in which Year Six pupils across the country take tests in Reading, Grammar and Punctuation, and Maths.

I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you all our school belief and approach to all elements of formal testing, whether that's the Y6 KS2 Tests, Y2 KS1 Tests, Foundation Stage 'Baseline Assessments', Y1 Phonics Check or the Y4 Multiplication Check.



At Ely St. John's, we always expect pupils to work hard, try their very best and bring a positive attitude to all that they do. Assessments are no different and we always are hugely impressed with the attitude and application of all our pupils no matter what their year group. 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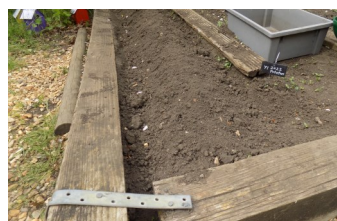


## Nature Garden + Allotment 'Big Help Out'
