2. Apostrophes are not used to indicate plurality (more than one)



**PLURALITY ONLY:**  
The two police **officers** are smiling.

**SINGLE POSSESSION:**  
One police **officer's** beard is brown.

**PLURAL POSSESSION**  
The two police **officers'** hats are blue.
