Our homework jobs this half term link to some of the learning that we are doing in school.

Please choose from the following tasks. We would like children to aim to complete one each week. If children have homework that they would like us to see, please help them to remember to put their books in the homework tray on a Wednesday. Books will be given back to children by Friday each week.

As well as an activity from this selection we would like the children to be reading regularly at home, both to themselves and aloud to an adult and practicing their multiplication tables. Spellings will also be set weekly.

<p>Make a list of appliances in your home that use electricity. Make a second list and this time divide it up into appliances that are battery powered and appliances that are mains powered.</p> <p>You can write or draw the appliances on your lists.</p>	<p>Create a poster or PowerPoint about a Roman topic that interests you. This could be Roman food, weapons, buildings, fashion, armies or something else.</p> <p>You might need to do some research about your chosen topic first.</p>
<p>Create a multiplication tables game. How you make your game is up to you. The aim of the game is to help the people playing it to improve their times tables knowledge.</p> <p>For example: times tables snap, pairs, a board game, a quiz</p>	<p>This half term we are learning all about the genre of music called jazz. Listen to a piece of jazz music and write down your thoughts and emotions as you listen. Think about the instruments, the rhythm and pulse, the tempo.</p>
<p>Write and illustrate a poem about autumn. Think about all the changes that happen in nature at this time of year.</p>	<p>Create a harvest picture. How you create your picture and what you use to do it is up to you!</p>
