

## **Fantastic Phonics**

<b>Day</b>	<b>Activity</b>
<b>Monday</b>	<p>Cut out your Tricky Word Cards. Read as many words as you can. We have learnt all of the orange and purple words in class. Some children may also know some of the green ones. If there are any that you don't know, try and learn them – maybe choose one to learn each day.</p> <p>Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p>
<b>Tuesday</b>	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>There are three ways that the 'ck' sound can be made: c, k, ck. Choose any book and find these sounds. Make a table to write some words with the different 'ck' sounds in (please see example below).</p>
<b>Wednesday</b>	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can in three minutes! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Write down the 'sh' digraph in your book. Look at the pictures below and write down a word to match each picture. Choose one of the words and write a sentence with that word in.</p>
<b>Thursday</b>	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet – time yourself to see how long it takes you.</p> <p>Write down the 'ch' sound in your book. Make a list of all the words that you can think of with the 'ch' sound in. Look around your house – can you see any objects with that sound in?</p>
<b>Friday</b>	<p>Read as many tricky words as you can! Point and say each letter and sound on The Jolly Phonics Alphabet/Digraphs and Trigraphs sheet.</p> <p>Read all of your orange tricky words again. Spell them out loud using the letter names. In your book, try and write them down without looking at them.</p>
