Medical Update Asthma



If your child has asthma and has an inhaler, please ensure that the school is aware.

It is important that children have their inhalers in school, that they know how to use them and they know where they are. All inhalers should be named both on the box and the actual inhaler itself.

Please bring in a copy of your child's asthma care plan (usually given to you by the asthma nurse or the doctor) and ensure that you have completed the school paperwork.

You should have filled in two lots of school paperwork...

- one an <u>asthma action plan</u> detailing symptoms, known triggers, information about the inhaler, how to use the inhaler and when.
- <u>permission slip</u> for us to be able to administer the <u>Emergency Asthma Inhaler</u> for your child if their inhaler is unavailable. Without this permission we would be unable to administer the <u>Emergency Inhaler</u>.

Most children either keep inhalers in their drawer or bag, so that they have easy access to them should they need them. Younger children's inhalers may be kept by the teacher in a place that is accessible for them to be reached quickly.

Children with asthma should have their inhaler (preferably with spacer and asthma clinic care plan) in school at all times, including on school trips and not rely on the school emergency inhaler. It is a parents/carers responsibility to ensure that inhalers are in date and to provide replacements when they expire.

Please let the school office know in writing if your child ceases to be asthmatic or is diagnosed as asthmatic so that we can amend their record; and also if the way they need to take their inhaler changes (for example the number of puffs, time to take it etc.)

If you are unsure whether you have let the school know that your child is asthmatic then please contact Ms Godfrey by emailing cgodfrey@elystjohns.cambs.sch.uk and she will be able to check for you.
