

Ely St. John's Primary School Weekly Learning – Year 3 WB 15th June 2020 Travel Agent Maths





When you go on holiday you might go to a travel agent to help you book. What kinds of things do you need to book when you go on holiday?

This week you have been asked to work for a brand new Travel Agent-EJ Travel.

<u>Monday</u>

Your first job is to help a family book and organise their holiday to South America. They aren't sure yet where in South America they would like to go, so you need to look at the cost of flights to help them make their decision.

Look at the table of flight prices on the sheet, and calculate how much it would cost for the family to fly to each place.

Make sure you show all your working out and organise your work clearly so the family can easily see the cost of each flight.

<u>Tuesday</u>

Well done for all your hard work calculating the cost of the flights! The family have made a decision, and have decided they would like to go to Brasilia (the capital of Brazil).

They have arrived at the airport, and would like to get some lunch before their flight. Can you help them calculate how much their lunch will cost? Look at the price list on the sheet, and answer the questions. Remember to show all of your working out! Wednesday and Thursday

Now the family have arrived in Brasilia they would like you to organise some activities for them to do.

Watch the video first to find out a little bit more about Brasilia, then look at the activities on the sheet and plan out an itinerary for the family to do on Monday-Friday while they are there.

You will need to show all your working out, and present your ideas really neatly so the family can clearly see what they are doing each day and how much it will cost.

<u>Friday</u>

Today you are going to price what it would cost for your family to go on holiday for a week in the summer holidays. You need to make sure you have booked enough places for all of your family members (No, you can't take the cat!)

You will leave on Friday 31st July, and return on Friday 7th August 2020. You can leave from any London airport. (Heathrow, Gatwick or Stansted) Remember to add up costs for flights and the hotel. Decide if you will need car hire, and add on your chosen vehicle.

Where will you go? There are some examples given, but if you would prefer to go online and search for a holiday yourself, please do so. Remember to book everything you need and write down all the costs carefully before adding everything up for a final total.
