Science Overview:

Week 5: Journey to the Centre of the Earth

LO: To describe what Inge Lehmann discovered about Earth's core

1. Open the presentation and talk about what is below our feet? What is under ground?
2. Next, introduce Inge Lehmann and read through the fact cards.
3. Then, using the fact cards, fill in the activity sheet. If you cannot print the sheet, copy it into your book. Choose the level of challenge that is right for you (Mild/Medium/Spicy).
4. Continue to work through the presentation.
5. Finally, if you have time, complete the paper model of Earth and its core using the Earth's Layers Interactive Visual Aid.

Challenge: Create a word search, which uses words linked to the topic of the Earth's core.
