## Summer B Learning Challenges

Chalk the numbers 1, 2 and 3 onto a wall or write them on paper and stick them up. Kick a ball twice, see which numbers you hit and add up your total score. You could challenge yourself by adding more numbers or kicking the ball 3 times. Have more than one go and see what your highest score is.

Extra challenge: Record your problem solving as a number sentence using the + and = symbols.

Practise your football skills. Look at the cards on the school website or watch the Footy Pups videos and then then have a go yourself. Which skill is easiest? Which is hardest? How many keepy uppies can you do?

Extra challenge: Teach someone in your family one of the skills that you have practiced. Remember to give them clear instructions.

Look at the 'Football is for Everyone' PowerPoint on the school website. Talk with someone at home about what you can see and what might be happening. Write a sentence about your favourite photo.

Extra challenge: Turn your sentence into a short story.
