This week the children have been sharing their knowledge of the seasons, talking about the signs of Spring that they have seen in the world around them. Many of the children have talked about visiting farms and seeing lambs, chicks, and other baby animals. We have also spent some time finding out about festivals that celebrate the arrival of Spring, noticing similarities and differences to other festivals that we have learnt about.

In maths, the children have been learning that halving is sharing a whole into two equal parts. They have explored this with practical resources and practiced quick recall of our halving Learn-its (half of 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10). The highlight was making toast and finding out the shapes we could make when cutting it in half!
