Daily tasks- reading, phonics and CLIC

Reading practise:

- Read for 10 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Can your child identify any questions in the text? Look for the question marks.

CLIC:

- Practise halving numbers to 20. Use equipment to halve the numbers if needed.
- Learn off by heart 0+10=10, 1+9=10, 2+8=10, 3+7=10, 4+6=10, 5+5=10
- Write out the fact families for your Learn its.
- E.g. 4+6=10 6+4=10 10-6=4 10-4=6 10=4+6 10=6+4 6=10-4 4=10-6. Demonstrate with equipment where necessary e.g. use lego bricks to build the calculations so the children see the solution.

Phonics:

Each day write the following words onto small cards. Introduce the sound and words to your child. Place them face down on a surface /table with a counter underneath each card. Can your child win the counter by sounding out and blending the word together?

- Day 1 oe toe hoe doe foe woe Joe goes tomatoes potatoes heroes mangoes
- Day 2 au sauce cause pause Paul haul daub launch haunted August author automatic
- Day 3 ey key money honey donkey jockey turkey chimney valley trolley monkey
- Day 4 ey (alternative sound) they grey prey obey disobey survey surveyor
