Please go through this task with your child.

Your task is to write a fact file. Your fact file could be about anything that you want! It could be an 'All About Me' fact file or it could be about your favourite animal or about a hobby you enjoy. It could be about the seasons or about something scientific. It could be something to do with history, such as a report about Kings and Queens. It could be about absolutely anything that interests you!

This piece of writing should not be completed on just one day. It should be a long piece of writing, so you should write a different section each day. Each section or paragraph should contain 4 or 5 sentences or even more.

Top Tips!

A Fact File should include;

- A Title,
- · Subheadings,
- Facts and information,
- Pictures,
- Did you know? bubbles.

In addition to the features of a Fact File, you should take into consideration the following;

- Spelling. Use the 'Phase 2 to 5 Sound Mat' and the 'Tricky Words Mat' below to help you.
- Correct punctuation. Sentences should ALWAYS start with a capital letter and end with either a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark. You will also want to use capital letters for the names of people and places.
- Include interesting Adjectives (describing words).
- Include conjunctions to make your sentences longer and more interesting. Conjunctions could include; and, so, but, because, or, when, if, although.
- Handwriting. Letters should be correctly formed. Letters should be correctly proportioned (tall letters, short letters, descenders below the line).
- When you have finished writing, can you edit and improve your work?
