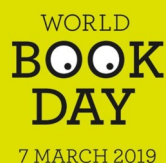


5th School Council Meeting

We put the information from our recent paper recycling audit with Mr Hambley into a chart to share with you in an upcoming assembly. Four classes took joint first place and will be revealed soon.

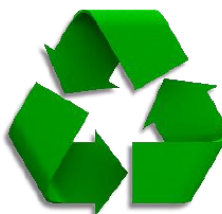
4. New labels for paper bins
