In Phonics this week, the children have learnt the following sound: **ea** saying /e/ as in **bread**.



Starting this week, there will be a weekly QR code sent home that will direct you to a website containing 40 words for your child to read at home. For those unable to scan the QR code, <u>this link</u> should take you there. The words are a mixture of both real and 'alien' (made-up) ones. We hope this helps your child's confidence when decoding and blending unfamiliar words so that they become more fluent in their everyday reading. This also serves as gentle preparation for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check held in June. If you have any problems accessing the website, please let us know. Thank you for your support.
