

Worksheet 1 - Answers

1.: $1/3 \times 7 = 7/3 = 2 \frac{1}{3}$. $2 \frac{1}{3}$ tanks of fuel are used.

2.: Method 1: $1 \times 4 = 4$, $2/5 \times 4 = 8/5 = 1 \frac{3}{5}$, $4 + 1 \frac{3}{5} = 5 \frac{3}{5}$

Method 2: $1 \frac{2}{5} = 7/5$, $7/5 \times 4 = 28/5$, $28/5 = 5 \frac{3}{5}$

3.a): $5/4$, $9/4$; $10/6$, $25/6$, $35/6$

3.b): There are many different answers. Some answers are:

$5/8$: $1/8 \times 5$, $5/8 \times 1$, $1/16 \times 10$, $1/24 \times 15$

$10/9$: $1/9 \times 10$, $2/9 \times 5$, $5/9 \times 2$, $10/9 \times 1$

$1 \frac{1}{5}$: $1/5 \times 6$, $2/5 \times 3$, $3/5 \times 2$, $6/5 \times 1$
