

4th School Council Meeting

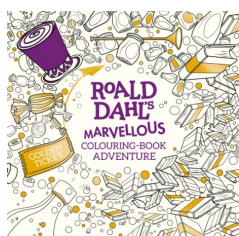
21st February 2018
