

Spring Learning Challenges!

<p>Look out of your window. Can you see any signs of Spring? Share your observations as a list of words or pictures.</p>	<p>Make a board game. Teach someone at home how to play. Extra challenge: Write the rules for your game.</p>	<p>Look at the links below with an adult to find out about Spring. Extra challenge: Record your favourite facts in your book.</p>
<p>Find out 5 fun facts about frogs and their lifecycle. For example: Where do they live? What do they eat? What is frogspawn? Extra challenge: Draw the lifecycle of a frog.</p>	<p>Learn the order of the seasons. Draw a picture for each season. You could show the weather, how plants change or special events. Which season is your birthday in?</p>	<p>Which season is your birthday in? What about other people in your family? Make a card for someone who is celebrating a birthday soon.</p>
<p>Use scrap paper to make finger puppets of baby farm animals and use them to make up a story about a day on the farm.</p>	<p>Sing Old McDonald Had A Farm. How many different farm animals did you think of? Draw the animals or write a list of their names. Extra challenge: Write the names of the baby animals too, e.g. sheep and lamb.</p>	<p>Find some pairs of socks from around your house and muddle them up. How quickly can you match them back into pairs? Use the 2s counting pattern to find out how many socks you have. Describe the different patterns on the sock using full sentences. Extra challenge: Draw a picture of your favourite sock and write a sentence to describe it.</p>
