Day	Activity

<b>Friday</b>	Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Find your Tricky Word cards and spell all of the orange words out loud using the letter names. Ask a grown up to find the purple tricky words: <i>was, my, you</i> . How quickly can you recognise and read these words? Ask a grown-up to hide all of the orange tricky word cards and the purple cards around the house (apart from <i>her, they, all, are</i> ). Go on a tricky word hunt and find all of the words, reading them as you find them! How quickly can you find and read them all?

## Monday:

Write a word to match each picture. Alternatively, use your letter and sound cards to make the words. They all include one of the digraphs that we learnt last week (ch, sh, th).
