Science: Forces and Magnets

Children will learn:

- how magnetic forces act at a distance, and can attract or repel some materials
- to identify, compare and group some magnetic materials
- to investigate the force of friction produced by different surfaces
- to plan and carry out a fair test and draw conclusions

RE: Christian Worship

Children will learn about how and why churches are different.

Music: The Recorder

Children will use and understand the musical staff and recognise notes BAGDEC.

Musical Instruments


Play and perform as a class using musical instruments:

Children will learn:

- how germs can get into our bodies and why we need to keep clean
- how to make healthy choices about diet, exercise and sleep



Geography: Cycling the Americas

Children will use Alastair Humphrey's novel, 'The Boy who Biked the World' as a basis for learnina:

- about the similarities and differences between the UK and countries in South America
- the names and location of countries in Central and South America
- about human and physical features in South America, e.g. Nazca Lines, Machu Picchu and the Andes mountains

Children will learn

• to develop skills in South American dance, benchball, athletics and kick rounders

Computing

Children will learn:

- to carry out internet research on countries
- to use Scratch to program simple commands

History: The Mayan Civilisation

Children will study the Mayan Civilisation and learn about:

- cities
- gods and beliefs
- daily life

Design and Technology:

Children will learn:

- to prepare and cook food from South American recipes
- to create a class Mayan stelae



Art and Design:

Children will learn:

- to copy and create their own South American artwork based on the Nazca lines
- to design and make Mola Art
