

Daily tasks- reading, phonics and Clic

Reading practise:

- Read for 10 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Try to read a variety of texts through the week - fiction, non-fiction and poems.

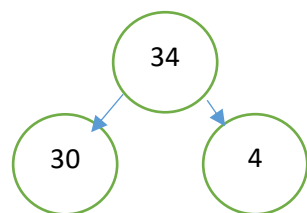
Clic:

- Each day practise counting in tens to 100 and back again.

Challenge - Can you count beyond 100 in tens?

- Learn off by heart $7+3=10$, $8+3=11$, $9+3=12$
- Practise partitioning 2 digit numbers.

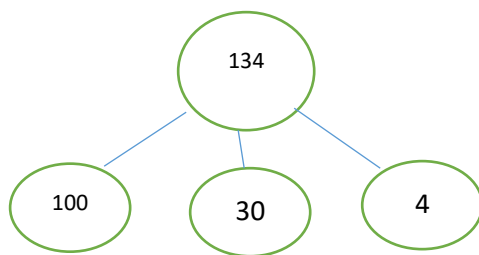
E.g.



$$34 = 30 + 4$$

34 = 3 tens and 4 ones

Challenge - Can you partition 3 digit numbers?



$$134 = 100 + 30 + 4$$

134 = 1 hundred, 3 tens and 4 ones

Phonics:

Each day write the following words onto small cards. Introduce the sound and words to your child. Place/hide them around the room or in your garden as a treasure hunt. Your child can keep the card if he/she can sound out and blend the word.

- **Day 1 - ch** - chin cheap cheek choose chip cheat cheese chop chase chunk chimpanzee
- **Day 2 - ch** - bench beach reach speech peach teacher poach church launch branch attach blowtorch
- **Day 3 - ch (alternative sound k)** school Christmas chemist chord chorus Chris chemical headache technical chronic
- **Day 4 - ch (alternative sound sh)** chef machine Charlotte brochure chalet chute parachute champagne
- **Day 5** - Enjoy using Phonics play to practise **ch**. Dragon's Den and Buried Treasure (Phase 5) are 2 exciting games to play. phonicsplay.co.uk
