


### Literacy session 3

Have a go at poetry writing and try to write an acrostic poem. An acrostic poem has a topic idea running down the left side of the poem. Each letter in the topic word has a new thought that runs off the side from left to right and is relevant to the topic word. The topic word is typically the title as well. Your title/topic word is going to be Plants.

Try to include at least one adjective in each line of your poem. You should now have lots of ideas of adjectives in your book to help you. Here are some examples to look at before having a go yourself.

P lants are green

L eafy and thorny.

A ir, water, sunlight they need,

N ice flowers, fruits and vegetables they give.

T rees, shrubs and grass

S oil is where they grow.
