Science: Living Things, Habitats and Humans

Children will learn:

- to explore and use classification keys to group, identify and name plants and animals in our nature garden
- how our changing environment is making life difficult for the hedgehog, and how we can help them
- to make and interpret food chains
- to describe the functions of the basic parts of the digestion system in humans
- to identify the different types of teeth in humans and their functions
- to record findings using labelled diagrams, keys, bar charts and tables

French: Healthy Foods / Going Shopping

Children will learn:

- to name fruit and vegetables
- to write a recipe for a salad
- numbers 41-50
- shopping dialogues and role play

Computing: Digital Images and Media

Children will learn:

- to use computer software to manipulate images, sound and music

RE: What is important to Jews about being part of God's family?



History: Ancient Greece

Children will be taught a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world. They will learn:

- to use sources of evidence for historical enquiry
- about life in a Greek family, the Greeks at war, the Olympic Games, Greek gods, food and theatre
- the story of the Greek battle with Troy

Geography: European Locations

Children will study the human geography of modern-day European country, including types of settlement, land-use, economic activity and natural resources.

Art and Design: Printing

Children will learn:

- to make printing blocks to create scenes inspired by designs on Ancient Greek vases

Music: Listening, Performing and Composing

Children will learn:

- to appreciate and understand music from Ancient Greece
- to perform songs and music linked to Greek myths (Heroes of Troy)
- to compose music using computer software

Design and Technology: Food

Children will plant salad in the allotment and use it to make a Greek salad.

PE:

Children will learn:

- to develop skills in traditional English dance, gymnastics, cricket and rounders, and athletics

PSHE: Growing Up / Financial Capability

Children will learn:

- about what 'grown up' means and how to take greater responsibility
- to identify some of the ways bodies are different at different ages
- about earning, spending, saving and budgeting money
