

# Active to Passive

In an **active** sentence, the **subject** performs the action (the verb) to the **object**.

In a **passive** sentence, the **object** gets turned into the **subject**.

Here's an example:

Active

John washed the car.

Passive

The car was washed by John.

Now change the following active sentences to passive:

1. The year 6 children deliver the milk.

2. The wind damaged the fence.

---

3. Your cat took the last biscuit!

---

4. The tiger gnawed at the bone.

---

5. Chris saw the Harry Potter film 'The Deathly Hallows'.

---

6. Sarah took her hamster to the vet.

---

7. Many people like cycling.
