Active to Passive

In an **active** sentence, the **subject** performs the action (the verb) to the **object**.

In a passive sentence, the object gets turned into the subject.

Here's an example:
Active John washed the car.
Passive The car was washed by John.
Now change the following active sentences to passive:
1. The year 6 children deliver the milk.
2. The wind damaged the fence.
3. Your cat took the last biscuit!
4. The tiger gnawed at the bone.
5. Chris saw the Harry Potter film 'The Deathly Hallows'.
6. Sarah took her hamster to the vet.
7. Many people like cycling.

Challenge: Now create three of your own sentences, writing the active version **and** passive version.
