Today we are looking at the digraphs: th and $n g$. <br> Remember that the 'th' digraph makes two sounds! <br> Ask a grown-up or older sibling to read the following words: that, this, with, ring, song, wing. Segment the words and write them in your book. Choose one of the words and write a sentence with that word in e.g. I like to sing songs with my dad. |
| Thursday | Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. Today we are looking at the digraphs: ai and ee. Look at the pictures below and write down a word to match each picture. Choose one of the words and write a sentence with that word in e.g. My feet got wet in the rain. |
| Friday | Watch and join in with the 'Daily Phonics' video on the school website. <br> Read all of your green tricky words. Spell them out loud using the letter names. In your book, try and write them down without looking at them. |
