Look at the example words (to the left) – notice how the words are layered over the top of newspaper. You could try this or use other things for a background.

You will need the following:

- A black felt-tip pen (or any other black pen)
- Coloured felt-tip pens these will stand out really well. If you have coloured pencils, you may need to apply pressure when trying to make the colour striking and bold.
- Paper
- Ruler (optional some people have used them to help when doing Ben Day Dots)
- Optional: collage materials (e.g. newspaper, coloured paper, a page from a magazine)
