Literacy Lesson 4 transcript

Hello again Year 2s! Welcome to our last literacy lesson of the week. I hope you've enjoyed our learning so far and I hope you've enjoyed our new story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. Hopefully by now you've become quite familiar with the story, you know it quite well. Maybe some of you have listening to it enough times that you could probably retell the story if someone asked you to. That retelling of the story is what we're focusing on today. We're going to try and think about putting the story events in the right order. So, you're going to have a go at retelling the story using the resource on the website. There is resource called 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch story sequencing cards' and we've done this before in school, this is an activity that will really help you understand the story and to remember the story as well. When you find that document there are lots of little cards about the story but they're all in the wrong order! So your job is to try and retell the story using the story sequencing cards and put them in the right order. There are guite a few cards because it's guite a detailed story. So remember if you want to listen to the story again, that's absolutely fine. Maybe you could do it both at the same time, you could have the story on in the background and have the cards in front of you and put the cards in order as you're listening. Or maybe some of you feel like you just want to have ago without listening to the story because you think you're familiar enough with the story by now. It's completely up to you.

So hopefully you can print these cards off. If you can then cut them out and you'll need some glue and you can stick the cards in the right order in your home school book or you don't have to do it in your home school book, you could get a big sheet of paper and create a really big story sequencing poster, couldn't you? That's up to you, it depends on what you've got at home. If you haven't got a printer then maybe what you can do is draw some of your own cards to retell the story. You could have a few cards for the beginning of the story using ideas from the website, and then you could have a card for what happens on Monday, then on Tuesday, then on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and finally Saturday. So you could draw your own story sequencing template couldn't you, if you can't print off the cards from the website. They're there to help you and so is the story on the website so please do listen to it again.

So that's your job today, just a quick video form me today. So, you're just going to retell the story by putting the events in the right order and see if you've learnt the story as well as I hope you have.
