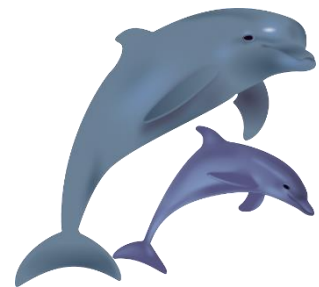
Ellie had 6 teddy bears.
