1. We gave feedback about this year's World Book Day. We thought that

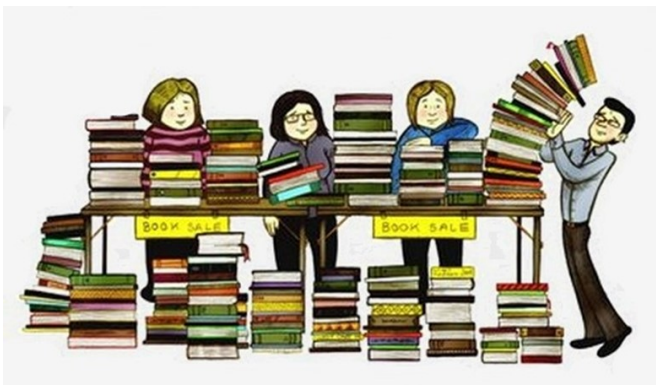
- the **'Snuggle up in your pyjamas'** theme worked well because it was easy for families to organise and also warm on a snowy day. A big hit!
