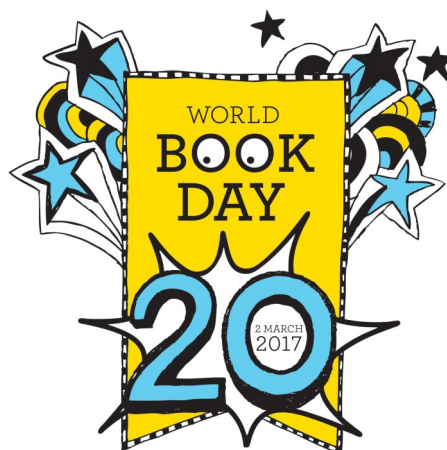


4th School Council Meeting

- 3) Upgrade the activity boxes in the quiet zone for KS1 and KS2

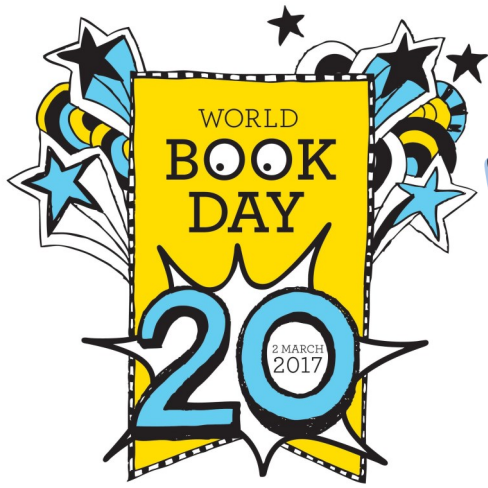


ACTION POINTS FOR CLASS COUNCIL:
